WHERE DO THE CANDIDATES FOR GOVERNOR STAND ON LIFE ISSUES?

Where do they stand on partial-birth abortions, in which fully-developed, living babies who can feel pain are stabbed in the head before their brains are suctioned out?

LYNN SWANN believes that partial-birth abortions should be outlawed. He supports the Partial-Birth Abortion Ban passed by Congress and now before the U.S. Supreme Court.

ED RENDELL supported only the NARAL *phony* "ban" that would not stop partial-birth abortions. He opposed the Partial-Birth Abortion Ban passed by Congress and now before the U.S. Supreme Court.

What about taking your tax dollars to pay for abortions or promote abortions?

LYNN SWANN opposes the use of your tax dollars for abortion.

ED RENDELL supports the use of your tax dollars for abortion and to promote abortion. (*Vetoed language passed by the legislature in the 2005 budget that would have prevented tax dollars from being used to promote abortion.*)

Should the section of the PA Abortion Control Act that prevents the destruction of *live* human embryos for scientific experimentation be repealed?

LYNN SWANN supports the PA law and opposes repealing it.

ED RENDELL wants to repeal the PA law to allow destruction of live human embryos for scientific experimentation.

Should unlimited abortion on demand for any reason or no reason remain legal?

LYNN SWANN believes that human life should be protected. He believes that the decision to protect unborn children and their mothers should *once again* be returned to the people, working through Congress and the state legislatures.

ED RENDELL supports *Roe v. Wade* which allows the killing of unborn children through abortion – **for any reason at any time** in pregnancy – even as birth control and in the form of infanticide called partial-birth abortion. (*Stenberg v. Carhart*)

What would happen in Pennsylvania when *Roe v. Wade* is overturned?

LYNN SWANN would sign legislation passed by the PA state legislature protecting unborn children and their mothers from abortion.

ED RENDELL would *veto any law* passed by the state legislature protecting unborn children and their mothers.
